

Minutes of IQAC Meeting on 22nd Feb. 2018

1. Dr. M.C. Damle briefed on "Minutes of last IQAC meeting dt. 10th Nov. 2017
2. Mr. P.N. Bhosale presented the observations on few points in AAA conducted for 2015-16 and 2016-17. He was advised to get clarity on all the points covered in AAA and present the summary report to Principal madam at the earliest and to IQAC in the next meeting.
3. Review of activities planned during Nov 2017 to Feb 2018 showed that the following activities have been rescheduled to March 2018
 - a) Celebration of World Aids Day by Final Yr. B.Pharm. class (TSC)
 - b) Personality Development Program for M.Pharm. Sem IV students(MRPR)
 - c) Faculty Development program (month not finalized)(MRPR)
 - d) Entrepreneurship development Training (SVB)
4. The proposed reform in Question paper setting was discussed. It is proposed that students of TY B.Pharm., Final Year B.Pharm. and M.Pharm. will be asked 20% questions to test their concept evaluation ability. After assessments of answer books, the percentage of students attempting such questions of higher difficulty level will be analyzed.
5. Dr. Damle stated that the number of "Instructional Days" in the first half of 2017-18 were as per the schedule of admissions and examination.



7. Dr. Chitre informed the committee about the likely composition and objectives of IPR cell at college.


