#### 1. Swachha Bharat Abhiyan (1<sup>st</sup> August-15<sup>th</sup> August 2017)

Swachha Bharat Abhiyan was conducted by the NSS unit during 1<sup>st</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> August 2017. The events were started with cleanliness oath on 1<sup>st</sup> August.
