About Course: This course aims to provide hands on training for all the Post graduate students

for all the sophisticated instruments in college.

Course Duration: 30 -35 hours staggered over a week (approximately 6 Hours per department)

Year: 2022-23

Calendar of Course: 1 hour daily for 30-35 working days

Course Content:

- > To study the basic of instrumentation of various analytical instruments in Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry like Muffle Furnace, Quantitative Microscopy and Soxhlet Extraction technique required for standardization of crude drugs.
- > To study the commonly used instruments viz., Cardiac (NIBP) Neuro (Elevated plus maze) Stereotaxic apparartus along with animal handling techniques followed as per good laboratory practices and guidelines of (OECD, CPCSEA etc.) in experimental pharmacology. To study route of administration and blood withdrawal techniques in laboratory animals also to learn Statistic Test using software. To study the Pharmacokinetic/Pharmacodynamic study in laboratory animal.
- To understand validation of analytical instruments like HPLC/HPTLC/ Stability Chamber/ spectrophotometer etc., & methods as per ICH/ USP guidelines, concept of quality assurance and quality control techniques.
- To understand instruments like IR Spectrometer, Rotary Evaporator and Microwave for optimizing various reactions for synthesis techniques. Also to understand Schrodinger software for drug discovery techniques.
- > To gain the hands on training of sophisticated instruments used in processing and evaluating of Pharmaceutical product such as Spray drier, High Pressure homogenizer,

Freeze dryer, Brookfield viscometer, Differential scanning calorimeter, Brookfield texture analyzer, Particle size analyzer.






