


ELIGIBILITY


All the regular students admitted in the concerned academic years.

What is the Honeywell Leadership Challenge Academy?


- The Honeywell Leadership Challenge Academy (HLCA), is a unique scholarship program for children of Honeywell employees, using interactive technology, science-oriented workshops and team exercises to teach them leadership skills in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM).
- Developed in partnership with the U.S. Space & Rocket Center (USSRC), the program is designed to encourage high school students from around the world to pursue STEM-related careers.
- In 2019, almost 300 students from 41 countries and 27 U.S. states and territories participated in HLCA.
- Since its launch in 2010, Honeywell, in partnership with the USSRC, has awarded more than 2,709 scholarships to students to attend the HLCA.

When does the program take place and where is it located?

- The week-long program runs twice each year. In 2020, it will be conducted from February 23-27 and March 1-5 at the USSRC in Huntsville, Alabama. Program dates do not include arrival/departure days.

Who can attend?

- HLCA is open to all students that will be 16-18 years old on February 20, 2020, and currently enrolled in high school. In addition, your parent/guardian must be a current full-time Honeywell employee.
- HLCA program materials are written and instructed in English. Your child must be able to read, write and speak English fluently to qualify.

What does the HLCA scholarship cover?


- Tuition, lodging, meals, transportation to and from the airport, program materials, and a flight suit are all covered by the generous HLCA scholarship.
- Parents are responsible for providing airfare to/from Huntsville, Alabama, and any costs associated with acquiring passports and visas.

What will students do during the Honeywell Leadership Challenge Academy?

- HLCA provides innovative activities that develop students' leadership skills through technology and science-oriented workshops, lectures, and team exercises. Activities are delivered in fun and exciting ways that bring STEM studies to life.
- Students meet scientists, engineers, and former astronauts who help reinforce core leadership competencies and share their first-hand experiences.
- Students engage in numerous team-building challenges such as designing, building and testing their own model rockets; participating in simulated astronaut training sessions; coding challenges; shuttle missions and moonwalk; performing scientific experiments and other unique activities. The program also includes a rocketry activity to introduce students to computer science.

How do students apply?

- Each year, several hundred students apply for admission to one of the two weeklong sessions. The sessions run consecutively. Entry into the program is granted after a rigorous application and review process based on academic achievement and community involvement.
- Each application is scored by a review team at USSRC based on essay content (350 words max.), current high school grade point average, extracurricular school activities and community involvement.

When are the scholarship recipients notified of acceptance into the program?

- The HLCA 2020 application will run from August 26, 2019 and close October 30, 2019. Scholarship announcements will be sent the week of November 6. All international students will receive a visa letter from Honeywell after the registration process with USSRC has been completed.
- If your child is selected to receive a scholarship, registration instructions from Space Camp will be sent immediately after acceptance letter from Honeywell. You must register with Space Camp to confirm acceptance of scholarship.

Is there a waitlist?


- Yes. A waitlist is also established in the event an accepted student is unable to attend.

Why does Honeywell sponsor the HLCA?

- Honeywell sees a need for increased STEM education and has been filling a gap with programs like the HLCA to help engage and inspire students to become our future engineers, coders, scientists and innovators.
