2. Our college team Anish Panwalkar and Ashutosh Mahamuni from S.Y. B. pharm. bagged First prize at Young Pharmacist's Innovative Project Competition 2019 with Cash prize of Rs. 15,000/- Organized by SVB's College of Pharmacy Dombiwali
3. Mr Vaibhav Ghegade, Mr.Siddharth Bhalerao of Final Year B.Pharm and Mr.Atharva Kulkarni of Third Year B.Pharm secured Second rank in IPA National Pharma quiz 2018 with Cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-, organized by Indian Pharmaceutical Association Andhra Pradesh on 8th Dec 2018.
4. **AISSMS college of Pharmacy received A grade for the first cycle from National assessment and accreditation council in the results announced on 2nd Nov 2018. After passing the prequalification stage, peer team visit took place on 21st and 22nd September 2018**
5. Savitribai Phule Pune University sponsored **National level seminar on 'Invitro Invivo Correlation'** was organized at AISSMS College of Pharmacy, Pune on 17th and 18th January 2019.
6. **National Pharmacy Week 2018-19** was held from **25th September to 1st October 2018** wherein our college secured first place in overall championship in UG level and runner up trophy in PG level.
7. **Alumni Meet 2018-19** was organised on 23rd February 2019 in the college auditorium by the AISSMS Pharma Graduates Association around 80 alumni graced the event.
8. **Graduation Ceremony** was organized as per SPPU directives on 12th February 2019. The ceremony was conducted successfully as per SPPU guidelines.
9. **Inhouse Sponsored Projects, outside student projects and industry sponsored project:** are carried out by the students under the guidance of the respective subject teachers. On completion of the projects the data is published in peer reviewed journals. This year 10 inhouse projects, 2 outside student projects and 1 industry sponsored project were enrolled amounting to Rs 49,920/- , Rs.21,406/- and 12,740/- respectively.
10. **Training and Placement cell:** 7 guest lectures were organized in 2018-19 on various topics.

In plant training: 64 students of Second year B Pharm completed their in plant training in pharma industries or retails/hospital pharmacies in May-June 2018

Industrial visit: an industrial visit was organized for TY B Pharm students to **Nulife Pharmaceuticals Ltd at MIDC, Pimpri on 14th Nov. 2018**. Four staff members i.e. Mr. Rahul Padalkar, Mr. Pradeep P. Sonawane, Mrs. Swati Kolhe and Mrs. Vidya Wable accompanied 64 students of Third year B Pharm.

Career guidance and personality development session was organized for **Final Year B Pharm** students on **20th July 2018**. Prof Ulhas Karkhanis and Prof Chandrahas Menon of IES Management College, Bandra, Mumbai were invited as resource persons, and a 30 h workshop was conducted for **M Pharm (4th Sem) from 3rd December to 7th December 2018** by Mahendra Pride School.
