SYNAPSE 2016

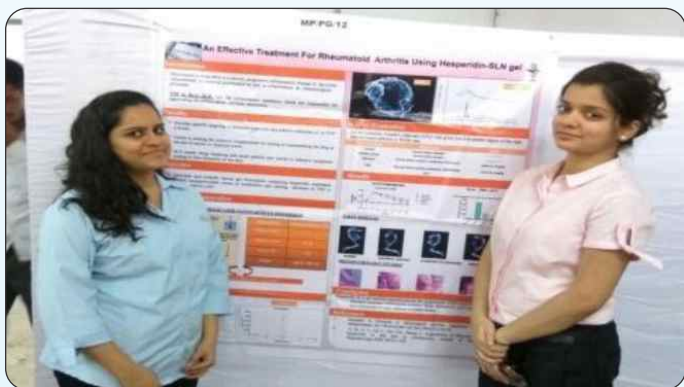

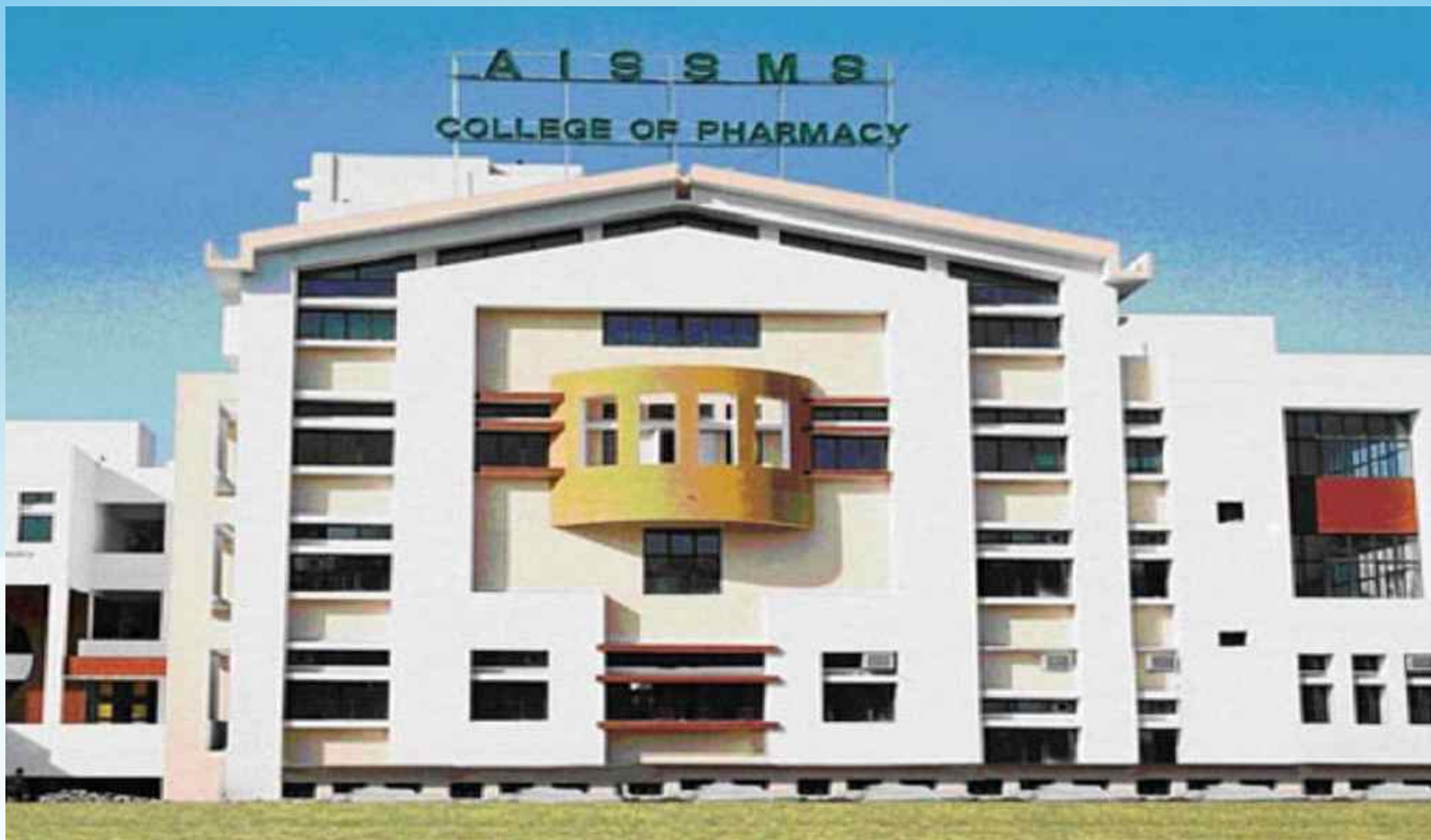
