

Did You Know:

Communication in Fungi

A recent breakthrough in the field of communications amongst fungi has been made by esteemed scientists of Brazil and the United States that shed light on the electric impulses sent across structures that might act as a means of sending signals. The discovery could serve as the basis for the development of more effective therapies to combat fungal infections. By gaining a better understanding of mechanisms that underlie these communications, the therapies against serious fungal infections can be combated with expertise. "There was a hypothesis that cells in the same species could communicate via these structures, called extracellular vesicles. We showed, using different methodologies, that this occurs in three species," said Fausto Almeida, an author of the article. Almeida is a professor at the University of São Paulo's Ribeirão Preto Medical School (FMRP-USP) in Brazil. The study has even shown that the firing rate of these impulses increases when the hyphae of wood-digesting fungi come into contact with wooden blocks. This raises the possibility that fungi use this electrical "language" to share information about food or injury with distant parts of themselves, or with hyphae-connected partners such as trees. Full article regarding the discovery has been published in mBio.

Scope of Pharmacy:

Food Inspection

A career as a food inspector comes with the responsibility to ensure the food is healthy for human consumption. A food inspector inspects the food processing entities, manufacturing companies, restaurants, and dairy farms to collect samples for investigating the quality of food ingredients and preservatives being used in the food product to be sold in the market. A pharmacist already being educated in regulatory affairs to a certain extent has an upper hand in better grasping the job of a food inspector. A career as food inspector comes with the responsibility of inspecting live animals and carcasses at a slaughterhouse or examining food imports at a port for mislabeling or other food safety issues. Inspectors report violations to the appropriate regulatory agency and are responsible for ensuring that foods are suitable for human consumption.

The most popular exam conducted for the recruitment of food inspectors is the All India Food Inspector exam conducted by Union Service Public Service Commission. There will be designated examination centers in every district of each state.







